

Department 12-Poultry

Department Rules

1. Ages 6-18, Poultry, Duck & Turkey exhibitor. Tikes & Toddlers Ages 3-5
2. Call superintendent by June 1st to pre-register all breed poultry. No late registration permitted.
3. Maximum 6 entries in breed classes in sections A-Q. 1 entry per market class, section S
4. Only A rated animals will compete for championship classes.
5. Will be checked for good health at check-in. No lice, mites, nasal discharge or animals will be removed from show. Superintendent decisions are final.
6. Poultry will be Pollurum tested before entering exhibit area. If market birds are caged separately they do not need to be tested.
7. Exhibitors may advertise/sell animals after the poultry show. All animals must be removed by 9am on Friday. Release time 8pm Thursday & 8am Friday.
8. Exhibitors will exhibit in only one showmanship class. Must show in showmanship in order to participate in market or breed class.
9. Must exhibit poultry in order to enter egg class.
10. Market poultry breeds (broilers, Cornish hens) may not be entered in breed class.
11. Exhibitors will clean their cages once per day.
12. Exhibitors will feed and water their animals twice daily; once before 9am and once after 6pm.
13. Dress Code: Black pants, long sleeve white shirt
14. Check in Sunday, 11-2 pm by appointment. Call Superintendent ASAP for time slot to avoid waiting.

Rules

1. Must raise, own, and care for animals
2. Proof of Purchase Date required will be checked.
3. Maximum of 2 small market animals in sale, one per class.
4. Market Record Books required for sale. No book – no sale.
5. Weigh-in at entry time
6. Register market animals by: Turkeys- Feb.1st, Ducks- April 1st, Broilers & Cornish- May 1st.
7. The project end date is the day of check in.
8. Buyers are responsible for processing of market poultry.
9. In order to sell, must have A or B placing, and must make weight to sell (over or underweight no sale)
10. Grand & Reserve must sell.
