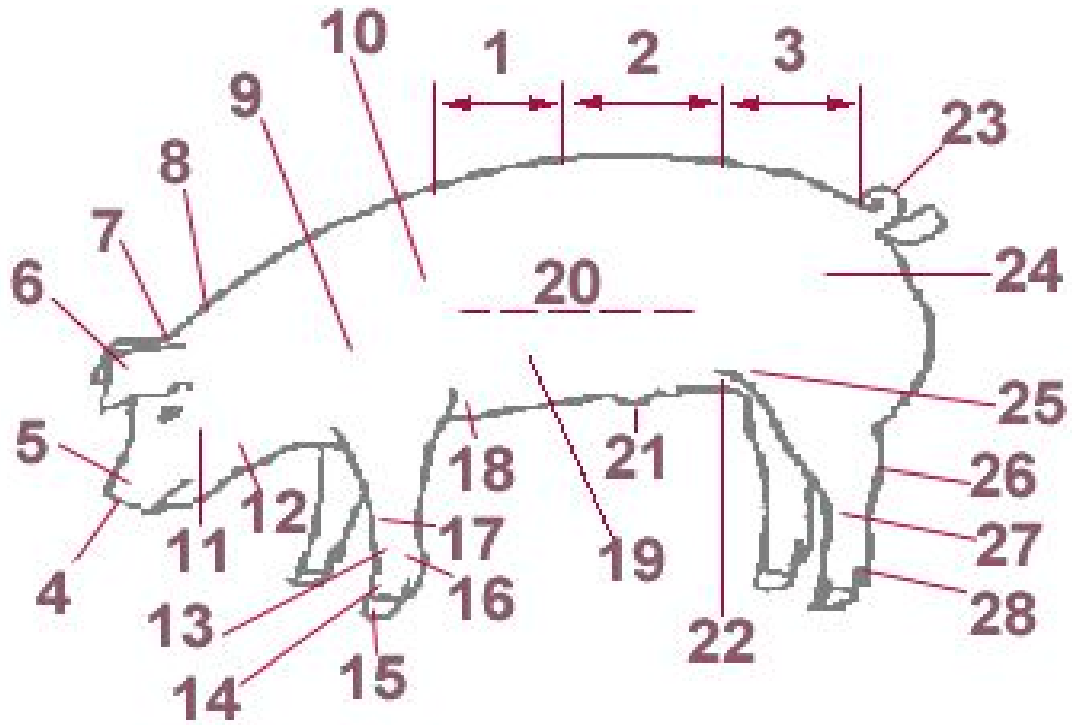

- _____ F. No energy, sleepy, rough hair coat, wrinkled skin, hard breathing, poor growth.
- _____ G. Infertility, abortions 15 days after breeding.
- _____ H. Worms in feces, decreased food intake, slow growth.
- _____ I. Infection of the mammary gland, udder hard and hot to touch, off feed.
- _____ J. Sneezing, tearing of eyes, snorting, coughing, twisting of nose (crooked)
- _____ K. Diarrhea containing blood and mucus, off feed, death in pigs less than three weeks.
- _____ L. Reproductive disease causing abortions, mummies and weak pigs
- _____ M. Reduced gain, poor growth and reproductive failures in the breeding herd.
