Rules:

1. Ages 6-18
2. Record Books and Posters due 9am Saturday at the horse arena, may turn in Friday 6-8 PM & picked up by 2pm Saturday.

3. Trailers to use Forward Road Entrance- No horse on show grounds before the day of the show.
4. Saturday Check-in: 7:45-8:45 AM
5. **Gymkhana:** ALL gymkhana contestants will register the evening of the event. There will be NO PREREGISTRATION for gymkhana events. **Registration time is 4:30 PM** by announcer booth. The youth show event points will count for that nights placings and will also contribute toward the MAYS Speed Series overall points. Contestant may ride more than one horse, but points will stay with each horse/rider combo. Each horse/rider combo will require separate entry forms and fees.
6. One horse, one rider per section, exception that immediate family members may share same horse in different sections. Only one rider per family per section.
7. 4-H Horse and Pony show rules & regulations apply for daytime events. Copies available from Superintendent or MSU extension office.
8. Ponies may be ridden in any riding level.
9. Superintendents reserve the right to make any changes before show time.
10. Release forms must be signed by parent or legal guardian at check in time, no other written form will be accepted. If a parent or legal guardian cannot be there at time of check in, contact a superintendent to make arrangements.
11. Beginner classes will be open to any exhibitor who is a first or second year show person. Clover buds age 6 & 7 years old will start over as beginners, first year at 8 years old.
12. Day classes are divided according to exhibitor's years of riding experience and/or showing experience in any show. Evening Gymkhana classes are divided according to exhibitor's age.
13. Questions please contact superintendent before completing entry form. State law: Proof of current legible negative Coggins

test inspected by a Superintendent is required before unloading animals.

14. It is *highly recommended* that **all horses be vaccinated with the minimum of a 4 in 1 vaccine and Rhino vaccine** at least 2 weeks prior to taking your horse out for the 1<sup>st</sup> time each year.
15. No infectious, contagious or toxicological disease are allowed, and horses will be removed.
16. Exhibitors will furnish own water pails & feed, clean up area after the show. There will be a designated place for manure/bedding. Fill in any holes horses dig at trailers.
17. There must be a minimum of 3 entries per class. Classes may be combined at the superintendent's discretion.
18. If there are too many entries in a class, it will be divided. The top 3 places from each class will compete again to determine class placing.
19. Riders are not allowed to trot/canter or run their horses outside of the arena or the designated warm up area. Absolutely no horses are to be ridden south of the goat and sheep barn.
20. All patterns including Reining will be posted by 9:00am on the announcer booth.

**Department- Swine**

- Department Rules
1. Ages 8-18

2. All swine must be in your possession by the 1st Saturday in May. A Letter of Declaration and pictures will be required and must be postmarked or emailed on or before date listed in pre-register rules.
3. Recommend swine weights are approx. 75 lbs. on the first Saturday in May, and born approx. January 20th – February 15th
4. Hair clipping, oiling, powdering, or use of show dressing at any time is PROHIBITED and will result in disqualification.
5. Market classes will be divided by weights and number of entries.
6. Market Record Book is required to sell.
7. Entry & Weigh-in Friday 9am-noon & 2-7pm. No Reweighs.
8. Grand & Reserve Champion animals must sell.
9. Market weight minimum of 200 lbs. and a maximum of 315 lbs. The exhibitor may bring their other tagged pig if needed to make weight. Swine over 315 lbs. will sell at 315 lbs. and will not qualify to show in market class. Swine under 200 lbs. will go home or may stay on grounds to only show in showmanship (not eligible for market class and may not sell in auction).
10. All market swine must also show in showmanship class and turn in a completed record book to sell.
11. Adult Showmanship Class
12. **No solid tarps on the sides of the barns mesh tarps only!**
13. **All swine must have RIFD tag in order to sell.**
14. **No swine will be auctioned if fed Payline. Testing will be performed at the fairboard or superintendents' discretion.**
15. **If opting not to sell an animal weighed-in, the office must be notified by 7:00pm the Friday of weigh-in and entry.**
